Job 14:14–Dead in grave till change come. (1 Cor. 15:52)
Job 14:21–Dead don't know when visitors at grave.
Psalm 6:5–In death no memory of God.

Wait in Grave:

Job 17:13-16–Dead wait in the grave, in the dust.
Job 14:14–Wait in the grave until our change comes.
Acts 2:29–David not in heaven, but in grave.
Acts 2: 34–David did not yet go to heaven.

Death Compared to Sleep:

John 11:11-14–Death compared to dreamless sleep.

John 11: 11, 14–Jesus called death sleep.

Psalm 17:15–Resurrection equated to waking from sleep.

Resurrection:

John 5:28, 29–Wait in graves till raised in resurrection.

1 Thessalonians 4:13-16–Not in heaven before living.

1 Corinthians 15:20-23–All go to heaven at same time.

No More Death:

Luke 20:35-37–Death for saints over after resurrection.

1 Corinthians 15:54, 55–Death ends at second coming.

Revelation 20:14–Death cast into lake of fire, ends.

Revelation 21:4–After heaven, there is no more death.

Spiritualism:

Isaiah 8:19–Should we seek dead on behalf of living?

Deuteronomy 18:10, 11–Christians not to seek spirits.

Revelation 16:14–False spirits of demons deceive.

Leviticus 20:27–Spiritualists were to be put to death.

Acts 16:16, 18–Avoid things with magic or spiritualism.

2 Corinthians 11:14–Satan takes different forms.

No More:

Psalms 37:9, 10–Soon, wicked will not exist anymore.

Psalms 104:35–Wicked consumed and will be no more.

Obadiah 1:15, 16–Wicked as though never been alive.

Psalms 37:36–After destroyed, wicked can't be found.

Isaiah 47:14–Fire burns up wicked until no fire left!

Malachi 4:1-3–Hellfire leaves nothing left but ashes.

Ezekiel 28:14-19–Satan will finally be gone forever.

Hellfire:

- Isaiah 11:4–In the end, Jesus will slay the wicked.
- Revelation 20:9–Fire comes down and destroys them.
- Revelation 20:5, 6–Wicked are destroyed two times.
- Revelation 21:8–Hell is called the second death.
- Revelation 20:14–Death and hades will have an end.

Reserved:

- Job 21:13, 30–No hell, reserved in grave for judgment.
- Jude 1:7–Hell, like Sodom, is not burning right now.
- 2 Peter 2:4-6–Final punishment not now, but reserved.

Forever:

- Revelation 20:10–Forever, but book is full of symbolism.
- Jonah 2:6–Forever sometimes used symbolically.
- 1 Samuel 1:22, 28–Forever, until they die. (Ex. 21:6)
- Psalms 92:7–Wicked destroyed forever, never live again.

Strange Act:

- Job 4:17–Is it fair to burn sinner forever? God is fair.
- Ezekiel 18:32–No pleasure in death of wicked.
- Isaiah 28:21–Destruction not normal for God
- Luke 9:56–God did not come to destroy, but save.
